

Here is the lesson plan I left for the guest teacher

Math 7 (periods 5 and 7)

Ask students to log into the class website and write the homework in their binder reminders and then check out today's lesson. I have left them instructions similar to the lesson below:

- 1) First students will watch a video lesson about the

Fundamental Counting Principal.

- a) There is a link to the video on the class math webpage.

Students should have the class website bookmarked on their devices, if not there is a link to the page on the Echo agenda.

- b) Students should take out their Chromebooks and

headphones. There are extra headphones in the box back on the TA desk. Please ask students **not** to wrap the cords around the headphones when they put them back into the bags.

- c) Students can watch the video with a partner. There are splitters in back with the headphones

- 2) After watching the video students should review lesson 9-5 starting on page 757.

Students should do the ***Got It?*** problems on pages 758 and 759 and then do **Guided**

Practice problems 1-3 on page 760. (I've put the answers to the practice problems on the website so students can check their understanding of the concept.)

- 3) When students are done with the lesson practice problems they can begin their homework. (page 761, #1-7 odds; page 764, #24 and 25)

SSR – Students can read on their devices or a traditional dead-tree book. No trips to the library. Extra books are under my desk

Please circulate around the room as students watch the video lesson. Some will need encouragement to keep focused on the video and not drift off to other websites.
