Hello AGGIES – I'm at a meeting today and you have a guest teacher. Please make sure you sit in your assigned seats. Make sure you personally do everything you can to make today feel respectful and enjoyable for the guest teacher.

Below are the instructions I left for the guest teacher:

- 1. Students should work in pairs to use the answers on the class website to correct last night's practice. (One chromebook for each pair of students.) Students need to stay in their current groups unless you need to reseat for tutoring (#4 below)
- If there are students who express the need for additional explanation, poll the class
 for students who feel like they understand the concept well enough to teach others.
 Reseat students as needed to facilitate teacher/learner pairs.
- 3. If students finish the practice problems before the end of the period, they can read or work on assignments for another class.
