How much money can we spend?

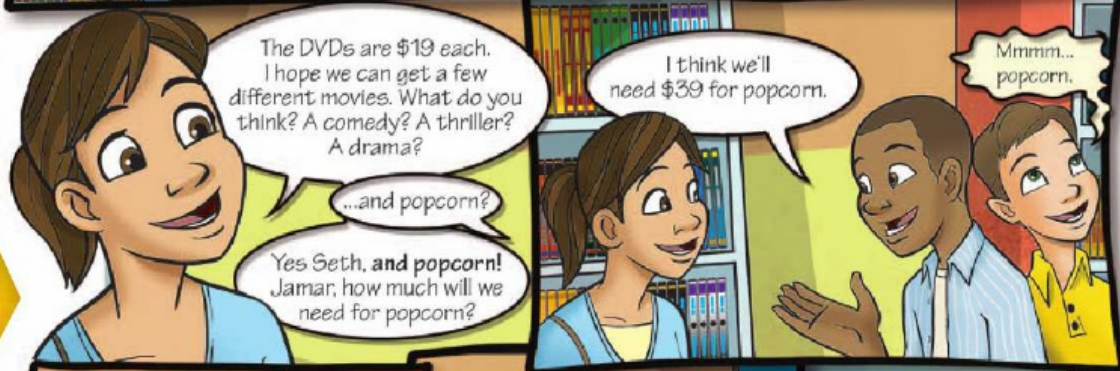
Don't forget the popcorn.
